

DEPAUL UNIVERSITY UNION SUMMER SCHOOL

The DePaul Labor Center offers two intensive one-week union summer school programs for high school students in the Chicagoland area and Ottawa, Illinois. The Chicago school meets at the DePaul Loop Campus, accessible by public transportation.

Prepare for college level coursework and learn what it takes to be part of the labor movement. Union Summer School students learn about labor history, collective



bargaining, and how organized labor is critical to achieving economic justice. Students completing the entire program receive \$100 participation stipend.

DEPAUL UNIVERSITY LABOR INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Beginning in 2015, the DePaul Labor Center will offer Chicago area internships for high school students at local unions and worker campaigns.
